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## INTRODUCTION

It gives me immense pleasure to publish the Annual Report of Ambedkar College for the academic year 2014-15.

Keeping in mind the aspirant educational zeal of the vast masses of the great catchment area, the progress of which is centered on the development of this seat of Higher learning, the Ambedkar College since its inception is growing day by day and imparting education to the youths of the rural area. And especially in past few years the progress has gain momentum which has been resulted into different developmental activities, viz. new academic and administrative buildings, ongoing work of the construction of auditorium etc.

Ambedkar College has completed twenty-four years of its academic excellence this year. It is a General Degree College functioning under the Dept. of Education (Higher), Govt. of Tripura. It is permanently affiliated to the Tripura University (A Central University) and is recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 2 (f) and 12 (B) since 2010. Under graduate teaching and research carried out on the beautiful campus, spread over 11.3 acre encompassing an old and a new campus. There are 11 departments and 1 center for Distance Education of Tripura University. From this year, i.e. 2014, the college offers three years (**Six Semesters** – 2+2+2) Under Graduate (UG) programs, i.e. Bachelor of Arts (B. A.) Honours and General and Bachelor of Science (B. Sc.) General, in different subjects, viz. Bengali, Education, Economics, English, History, Political Science, Philosophy, Sanskrit, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics, in **Choice based Credit System (CBCS)**.

This year the college has got its new Academic and Administrative buildings, the formal inauguration of which was done by the Education Minister, Govt. of Tripura, on 1<sup>st</sup> Nov. 2014. The college has a well equipped computer lab to provide the knowledge of ICT to the students. Some of the class rooms are equipped with Smart Class Room facility as sponsored by UGC and NMEICT, Govt. of India. Old campus is being monitored by CC camera. All the class rooms are well equipped with modern and sophisticated Electronic Teaching Aid. Science lab (Physics and Chemistry Lab) has been set up in the new academic building. One well equipped Language lab has been set up for spoken English and Spoken Sanskrit. Both the campuses are Wi-Fi enabled. The college provides reprographic facility for student in an affordable rate. Inlib-net has been subscribed by the college library to enhance the research activity of teachers. The college takes initiative for library Automation. This College runs a center for Distance Education of Tripura University to help the working man and woman of this rural area to fulfill their aspiration for higher learning. Proposal for opening of a study Centre of IGNOU has already been sent to Regional Centre. Proposal to

start NCC Boys Unit is already approved by DHE. The college has taken initiative for its accreditation by NAAC for which the LOI has been submitted on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2014 and the SSR submitted on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2014.

Besides the above mentioned planned curriculum the college authority always takes efforts for the all –round progress and development of students. The aim is not just to impart knowledge to the students but also to inculcate in them-wisdom, compassion, humanism, skills, attitude, knowledge and values that will allow them to participate and contribute positively in an ever changing world. The college has a Career and Counseling cell which helps and guides students for their future career. The College recently proposed to NEILEIT Agartala to offer one short term course on computer literacy and spoken English (free of cost) for the students. The programme will be started from March 2015. The college always continuously organize seminar/ workshop/training programme to make their students morally sound and to aware on different current issues of society. The NSS unit always motivates students to serve for the common people of the society. The unit regularly organizes awareness campaign, blood donation and health check up etc.

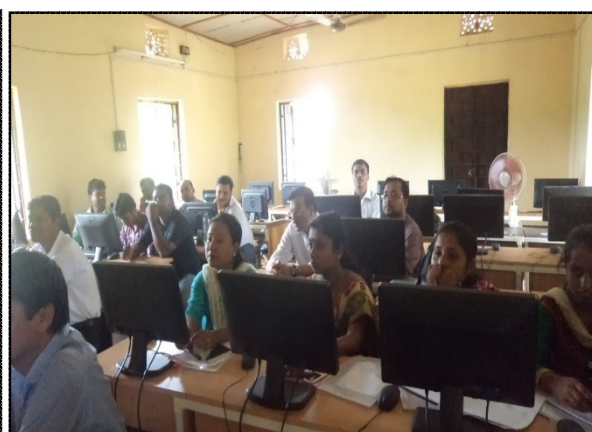

d. **Initiatives to improve the academic atmosphere :**

- From the current academic session 2014-15, B.Sc. Physical Science (General) Course been introduced to facilitate study in Science stream, a longstanding demand of the region fulfilled with this introduction.
- The college established a well-equipped Language Lab in the new Academic building during August 2014. This facilitates students to be acquainted with Spoken English and Spoken Sanskrit.
- Wi-Fi enabled Campus.



- Proposal to start B.Sc. (Bio Sc.) and Economics Honours from the forthcoming academic session, i.e. 2015-16, has been sent to the competent authority.
- For ICT training proposal to NEILEIT, Agartala already sent through DHE and considered for conducting the programme in March-April 2015.

## ii. Administrative

- **Library:** This year it has been shifted to the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the new academic building with comparatively good space lightning and arrangements, and equipped with computers with internet connectivity. Also to provide photocopying facility to the students in an affordable rate the library is equipped with a photocopying machine. The library is now having a small reading room. 195 numbers books have been purchased for the library in the current financial year.

Initiative has been taken for the automation of the library, for which the contract has been awarded to the DESIRE MAPPING TECHNOLOGY Pvt. Ltd., Kolkata.

- **Computerisation:** The computer lab has been shifted to the new academic building with better arrangement and increased number of seats to accommodate more students at a time. Therefore 18 numbers of computers and other related accessories have been purchased in this year.
- **Conduct of Examinations:** In view of the introduction of **Six Semester Choice Based Credit System** a new exam pattern was introduced from this year, in which three internals become compulsory prerequisite for students to seat in the final examination. It was necessary to put forth an internal effective mechanism with supportive infrastructure for the smooth conduct of examinations including internals. Therefore, in this year a separate examination section, which was earlier within the academic section, has been setup with basic infrastructures like computer, printer etc.
- **Infrastructural Development:** The institution builds and maintains infrastructure in keeping with academic requirements. Annually the different committees of the institution and other stakeholders come together to see that the institution is in line with the academic requirements of the community we serve. Following are few specific infrastructural facilities developed/ augmented/ in this year.
  1. Setting up of Computer lab
  2. Library with reading room, photocopying and internet facility
  3. Installation of water purifier & Fire extinguisher
  4. Smart class room equipped with multimedia projector
  5. Seminar hall with projector, motorised screen and LCD TV
  6. Construction of approach road from old building to new academic road from MGNREGA scheme

7. Construction of river side road with black toping from State Govt. Agency – PWD
8. Construction of approach road (brick soling) from Administrative Block to New Academic Block.
9. Filling up of ditch in front of Administrative building from BADP fund.

1. Proposal for boundary wall of entire campus – Estimate already prepared by PWD and sent to DHE for approval (project cost estimated for Rs. 1,39,67,580).
