What is IPR

Intellectual Property Rights are the legal rights accrued on property, tangible and intangible, created primarily from activities of the human intellect. It provides material awards and recognition to the inventors and contributors for their investment. These rights are governed by the law on intellectual property rights of the country which grants such rights.

Why IPR

As any movable or immovable property is legally protected from being stolen, in the same way this law protects the moral and commercial rights of an intellectual property owner.

Different forms of IPR

The Trade Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (TRIPs) in the agreement of World Trade Organization (WTO) recognizes seven forms of IPR, viz. patents, designs, trademarks, copyrights, geographical indications, integrated circuits and trade secrets.
