In order to maintain smooth academic activities and to overcome the current shortage of teachers all the Govt. General Degree Colleges/ Professional/ Technical Degree/ Diploma Level Technical Institutes run by the Education (Higher) Department are authorized to engage Guest / Visiting Lecturers for 11 (Eleven) Months during the academic year 2026-27 on payment of ₹500/- (five hundred) only per class with a maximum ceiling of 72 nos. of classes allotted to a Guest Lecturer per month (i.e. ₹500/- x 72 classes = ₹36,000/- per person per month). Engagement of said Guest / Visiting Lecturers will be made on merit basis by way of maintaining the reservation policy of the State Government.

1. In addition to class-room teaching, the Guest Lecturers may also perform academic duties as may be assigned to him/her by the College authority. However, the direct teaching by each Guest Lecturer should not exceed the maximum ceiling of 72 classes per month during his/her engagement period of 11 months, as concurred by the Finance Department.
2. The Colleges/ Institutions shall strictly follow UGC Regulations or AICTE Regulations, as applicable, for engagement of the Guest Lecturers.
3. A Guest Lecturer engaged in a College/Institute shall not be allowed to be engaged in any other College/Institute.
4. The Honorarium of the Guest Lecturers shall be drawn from the necessary funds as allocated to the College/Institute.
5. The number of allotted Guest/ Visiting Lecturer for engagement by each Colleges/ Institutes is attached at **Annexure-A**. The Principal/Principal-in-Charges Colleges/Institutes are directed to engage Guest Lecturer as per the allotment number mentioned at **Annexure-A**.
6. This is issued with the concurrence of the Finance Department communicated vide their **U.O. No. 615/FIN(ESTT.-III)/2026 dated 07/09/2026 and U.O. No.670/FIN(ESTT.-III)/2026 dated 16.09.2026.**

2. Considering the urgent academic requirement, the Colleges/Instiutes may proceed with the process of floating advertisement and conducting interviews as per the normal procedure. However, the **declaration of results of the selected/successful candidates shall not be made before completion of the election process and withdrawal of the Model Code of Conduct (MCC).**
3. In view of the above, all concerned Colleges/Institutions are hereby directed to **strictly comply with the aforesaid direction of the State Election Commission** while undertaking the process of engagement of Guest Lecturers for the academic year 2026-27.
4. The Principal/ Principal-in-charges shall ensure that **no result of the selected/ successful candidates is declared before completion of the election process and withdrawal of the MCC.**
