NOTIFICATION

Exit Option after 3rd Year or 2nd Year

Students enrolled in the **Four-Year Undergraduate Curriculum Framework, 2023**, under Tripura University, based on the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**, are hereby informed that the following exit options are available:

1. **Exit after 3rd Year (6th Semester):** Students who have successfully completed up to **six semesters (three years)** of the programme may opt to exit the programme and shall be eligible for the award of a **Bachelor's Degree with Major**.
2. **Exit after 2nd Year (4th Semester):** Students who have successfully completed up to **four semesters (two years)** of the programme may opt to discontinue the programme and shall be eligible for the award of a **Diploma with Major**.

Students interested in availing themselves of the above exit options may log in to the **Student Samarth Portal** and submit their **intent to exit** through the designated online process.

Students are advised to carefully evaluate their academic and career goals before exercising the exit option. They are also encouraged to consult their teachers and mentors to make an informed decision. This initiative is in accordance with the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**, which provides for multiple entry and exit opportunities in higher education.

Steps to Apply

The detailed steps for submitting the exit application through the Student Samarth Portal are attached herewith below:

Students are advised to complete the online Exit process within the period from 01/09/2026 to 20/09/2026. No application for Exit will be entertained after the expiry of the stipulated period.
